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DEFINITIONS:

- Academic Classes* - core required classes; such as, Math, English, Science, and History, including Regents courses
- Enrichment Classes* - special area classes; such as, gym, art, music, photography, drama etc.
- Gym Classes* - offered during the school day as an enrichment choice for Academic Affiliation students
- Sport Teams* - offered after school hours for Academic and/or Sport Affiliation students

REQUIREMENTS for Academic Affiliation

1. An application must be completed and a personal interview held with the Coordinator either in person or by telephone. The King's School reserves the right to determine acceptance into the Affiliated Home School program, and this relationship is subject to review upon request or the discretion of the Coordinator or the School Administrator.
2. If accepted, an application fee of \$500 per year per student must be paid to The King's School. It is due with application. (This fee only entitles the student to Academic Affiliation status; it does not pay for other individual items; such as, yearbook, sport, or field trip fees.)
3. Students must be academically affiliated for a minimum of two years (or pay two years' worth of affiliation fees) to be eligible to receive an Affiliated Home School Diploma issued by The King's School, providing that all academic requirements are met. (This is now being required by New York State colleges and universities as a prerequisite for enrollment, if the student has not received a GED.) To be eligible for graduation/award of a diploma, The King's School must be in receipt of the student's complete transcript, demonstrating that he/she has met or exceeded minimal graduation requirements.

The home schooling family must notify The King's School by January of the year of graduation as to whether or not the student wants to receive an Affiliated Home School Diploma and/or the student wishes to participate in the graduation ceremony. The affiliation fee does not include graduation fees for such items as caps, gowns, diplomas, and diploma covers. (The student may choose to simply receive the diploma by mail without participating in the graduation ceremony.)

4. If the academically affiliated student wishes to attend academic and/or enrichment classes at The King's School, there will be an additional fee of \$250 per credit, per student, for a maximum of 3 credits per year.

5 days a week = 1 credit = \$250 / 2 to 3 days a week = 1/2 credit = \$125 / 1 day a week = 1/4 credit = \$62.50

5. A letter of intent stating a list of the classes and curriculum your student(s) will be taking at home or elsewhere (including location), and/or a list of classes your student would be attending at King's must be supplied upon enrollment or re-enrollment.
6. The affiliated family must report quarterly to The King's School, delineating material covered and the grades received in each subject area for each student. (This requirement would eliminate the need for the home schooling family to file an IHIP with the local school district; however, the family may choose to report to both the local district and to The King's School.)
7. The King's School reserves the right to require testing in addition to the instructing parent's curriculum and/or periodic work samples from courses taken at home.
8. Any affiliated student wishing to attend on-campus classes must comply with all The King's School's policies including attendance, dress code, standard of conduct, etc. Please obtain a school handbook to be completely informed of The King's School's policies and procedures and to be able to sign and return the school Standard of Conduct.

PRIVILEGES of Academic Affiliation

1. Academically affiliated students may attend a maximum of 3 credits of academic and/or enrichment classes at The King's School per year.
2. The academically affiliated student may go on regularly scheduled field trips for his/her class. (An additional fee may be required, as outlined in above section.)
3. Academically affiliated students may participate in high school graduation exercises and receive a high school diploma for affiliated students, providing that all requirements are met.
4. The academically affiliated student may participate in The King's School sport programs and play on The King's School sports teams. (An additional fee will be required, as outlined in above section.)
5. Affiliated students may take Regents exams at The King's School, and may qualify for a Regents or Advanced Regents diploma issued by The King's School, if the necessary requirements are met. Affiliated students who are enrolled in a course at The King's School may take the Regents exam for that course with no charge. Contact the school office for Regents requirements, registration deadlines, and fees for Regents exams for courses taken from home..
6. Affiliated students may take PSAT exams (11th grade) at The King's School. Contact the school office for registration deadlines and fees. (The SAT is administered elsewhere.)

7. Affiliated students may participate in Stanford Achievement Testing, administered in the spring for selected elementary grades. Contact the school office for registration deadlines, fees, and grades that will be tested.

REQUIREMENTS for Sport Affiliation

1. An application must be completed and a personal interview held with the Coordinator either in person or by telephone.
2. If accepted, an affiliation fee of \$100 per sport played (\$125 for basketball) per year per student must be paid to The King's School. (This fee only entitles the student to Sport Affiliation student status; it does not entitle the student to the privileges of the Academic Affiliation program.)
3. All sport affiliated students must understand, sign, and comply with the Sport Rules and Procedures form provided by the school office. The Sports Rules and Procedures form addresses such issues as dress code, attendance to practice and games, and academic requirements.

PRIVILEGES of Sport Affiliation

1. Sport affiliated students may play in all home and away games and attend after school practices.
2. Sport affiliated students are supplied a King's School sports uniform, which is returned to King's at the end of the sport season.
3. Sport affiliated students may attend our formal annual Sports Banquet in the Spring. Student must pay for his/her dinner ticket.
4. Sport affiliated students are eligible to receive trophies, pins, and letters at the annual Sports Banquet.
