CORE SCHOOL VALUES:

ART FORMS:

The arts are a very broad form of expression that can belong to one, but not limited to the following genre:

Photography – research paper on famous photographer, and shoot in the style of chosen photographer

Drawing – print making, charcoal, pastels, graphite

Clay – sculpture, functional, decorative

Painting – watercolor, tempera, acrylics

Sculpture – wood, metal, found objects, mixed media

Mixed Media – collage, more than one main medium

Dance

Presentation of original writing

Music – vocal or instrumental

Dramatic Presentation
