

Re: After School Programs**August, 2021**

Dear After School Program Parent/Guardian,

Have your kids already mentioned their excitement for skiing and snowboarding this winter? I know mine have! I can tell you the staff at West Mountain is just as excited for the winter season and your children's arrival for our After School Programs.

We understand there are a lot of uncertainties right now, and we wanted to let you know that the West Mountain staff is very sensitive to that and is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for your kids this winter with well-established safety guidelines that will be well communicated before the programs begin Monday, January 3, 2022. This will allow your children to be safe and have fun outdoors this winter at West. As many of you know, we have been operating our Aerial Treetop Adventure Park, Mountain Biking and Summer Camps all summer with state and country mandated safety guidelines in place. We will be just as diligent this winter. We are fortunate that we are an outdoor recreational area offering fresh air and wide-open spaces for our guests. However, to help protect our guests, our employees and our communities amid this pandemic, some changes will most likely be required this season and we will keep you informed as more information becomes available.

Please also know that if your child's or children's schools are unable to organize the After School Program this season, that the programs will still go on and will be run and organized by the mountain at the same rates and the days of the programs will still apply. Children will just need their own transportation and chaperone (if necessary).

Please make sure to read over the information below and contact your school's After School Program Organizer with any questions. But remember, if the school does not organize the program, you will need to contact West Mountain directly with questions.

21-22 AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM DETAILS:

- The biggest change again this season is our new registration system. You can now register your child or children for our After School Programs at westmountain.com and select your child's school.
- The After School Program runs one day a week for six consecutive weeks (excluding holidays) beginning on January 3, 2022. The day – and if applicable lesson time – are selected by your school organizer and by the mountain.
- All After School program participants receive additional perks such as discounted tubing tickets, discounted ski tickets, discounted adventure park tickets, discounted rentals and more, which can be purchased online using a private link that will be emailed to you once your child or children are registered! Please see the flyer attached for details.
- The discount deadlines will remain the same as last season: October 31, 2021 and November 30, 2021. Please see the flyer attached for rates and additional cutoff dates.

Lift Only: Includes a program pass for the chosen weekday (non-holiday), and can be used on that day for the length of the 6-week program from 3:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. If children choose to ski prior to 3:00 p.m. or on snow days they must purchase a \$35 ticket. Additional ticket information can be found on the flyer.

Add A Lesson: We recommend all After School Program participants enroll in lessons to advance their skills. Lessons involve a 1.5-hour group session where skiers and riders are grouped by age & ability. Skiers & snowboarders of all levels will have 6 weeks to learn to ski and snowboard while meeting new friends. A lesson is a great way to start things off.

Add Rentals: Our Rental shop, located at West Mountain, offers two types of discounted rental options:

1. Season-long rentals that you keep at home for the season and can use anywhere, and
2. Six-week rentals that you keep at West which can be used during your program.

All renters will need to visit West Mountain Sports (across the courtyard from the Main Lodge) to be fitted for your equipment ahead of the season. Seasonal renters should register for the program early and stop in during the fall season to be fitted for equipment to take home and keep for the season.

Add A Meal Plan: The Meal Plan includes 6 meals to be redeemed during your child's program time and day of the week. Each student has the option to choose one from the following:

- ½ sandwich
- Cup of soup or chili
- Popcorn chicken
- Hamburger
- Hot dog
- Grilled cheese
- Slice of pizza

Students can also add a small salad or fries as well as add a small fountain drink or milk.

Please review the enclosed flyer for more information. Note that a \$15 late fee will be applied to all orders and adjustments placed after registration closes on 12/24/21.
