In an attempt to fulfill our mission statement of "Preparing Tomorrow's Leaders Today," The King's School has been integrating technology within instruction more and more over the past few years. The development of technological skill sets and understanding of digital citizenship are essential in the 21st century workplace and communities.

This year, The King's School is still requiring students 5th through 12th grade to bring to school each day their own Chromebook for educational purposes. The Chromebook's WIFI address (not the IP address) and consent for your student to use a King's Google account (please see the last 3 pages for more info) are required to provide your student access on our network.

Any Google Chromebook that has been purchased in the last three years should be compatible within our buildings. Feel free to purchase any brand with the specs to your liking. I would recommend that a newly purchased device has at least 4 gigs of memory/ram, 32 gig hard drive, a webcam, and that Google will provide support for at least another 4-5 years. (Keep this in mind if you are looking at a refurbished device.)

If you are unable to purchase your own Chromebook and are interested in finding out more information about leasing a device from The King's School, please refer to <u>Chromebook Lease Agreement Form</u>. Computers will be given out on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please send an email to <u>main_office@kingsschool.info</u> as soon as possible.

Before the first day of school, please sign the permission slip below and list your device's WiFi Address (instructions attached). If you are registering more than one student, please list each of their names and IP addresses in this form. Also, please read and sign the Google Account Agreement below. Thank you.

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GOOGLE ACCOUNT AGREEMENT FORM: 2022-23

This form is for student email accounts. All parents must sign.

This year at The King's School, we will continue to implement Google Classroom into our curriculum for grades 4th-12th. This platform will give students the ability to submit work digitally and collaborate with one another within a virtual classroom. Our goal as a school is to provide our students with the opportunity to enhance their 21st century skill sets and to give them the experience of using a digital platform that they will likely use if they continue their education at the post-secondary level.

In order for your child to have access to Google Classroom, Docs, and email (4th-6th graders will only be able to send and receive messages internally), they will be given a King's student Google account to gain access. The account can be reviewed by the school's Administration and revoked at any time. All activity through the account, as well as internet use within the school, is subject to the King's School Student Code of Conduct. We recommend that you have access to the student's account after your child establishes their own password.
