

KINDERGARTEN



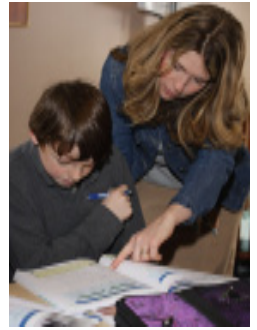
Our Kindergarten program is divided up into morning and afternoon sessions.

Morning kindergarten is dedicated to the core academics, reading, writing, math, & Spanish. The children learn sounds, letters, and how to blend together the consonants and vowels through the A Beka program. Math is taught with the use of a wide variety of manipulatives.

Afternoon kindergarten is committed to structured inquiry and facilitated play as an ideal vehicle for early learning. Through formal and self-directed activities, the afternoon Kindergarten provides a rich and balanced environment where students are encouraged to take risks in their learning and assume responsibility for themselves. Each of the students are unique and important, and we get to know who they really are! What makes them smile? What makes them angry? How do they learn? What do they do best? The afternoon Kindergarten classroom provides intellectual activities tailored to each child, connecting with who they are and their multiple intelligence strengths. It focuses on learning about God's world and how the study of science points to the majesty of the Creator. K-9th grade students learn inquiry, questioning, and analysis, soundly based on scriptural values.

SAXON MATH:

We use Saxon math for grades K-6. The students enjoy learning with the hands-on approach. The curriculum covers practical math concepts to give students a great foundation for later math learning and life beyond school. The daily story problems connect these concepts to real life applications.

Our Scotts Foresman elementary reading and history curricula were meticulously selected for their central purposes of critical thinking skills.
